### Community Classes and public performance programme

The new building will enable us to launch a community engagement programme onsite with community classes for all ages. A weekly timetable is likely to include classes such as dance, yoga, storytelling, nutrition, mindfulness, HIIT, drama, creative writing and an intergenerational community choir.

We aim to engage approximately 100 people a week in this programme from April 2023. We hope to increase participation numbers over the next 3 years, engaging approximately 300 people a week by 2026.

The building's auditorium (150 seats) will host student performances. In a usual year (non COVID-19) we would expect to programme approximately 20 student performances.

### **External Hires**

We are keen to offer areas within the building for hire to external organisations. However this area of work is still to be scoped out and we are unable to provide projections at this time. Whilst we would still like to see your menu examples for this area of work, Contractors should not include external hire figures within their financial projections.
