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



# STUDENT SUPPORT TEAM

Our incredible team includes members from our senior leadership team, a qualified nurse, a 1-2-1 student welfare officer, SENDCO, learning mentor and a team of student mental health ambassadors.

# OUR PRIORITY IS WELLBEING

Our approach to wellbeing is not 'one-size-fits-all'. We know that every person is different and pride ourselves on knowing our students really well, so that we can offer personalised support.

# CONNECT & REFLECT

Connect & Reflect is our tutorial programme. As well as your subject curriculum, all students explore key global topics with their form tutor to positively engage with the world around us.

# FINANCIAL SUPPORT

We offer incremental financial support for lower income families to cover the costs of equipment, trips, meals and merchandise, as well as additional support for students travelling long distances to access our provision.

# DEVELOPING INDEPENDENT LEARNERS

We understand that not every student learns the same and staff are well trained to support the needs of all learners. We encourage the use of technology to support academic qualifications.

# **SEND**SUPPORT

Students with educational needs are supported to manage the demands of their course, in class and around the building. Students can access a range of 1-2-1 and small group interventions, overseen by the SEND team, to ensure that no student is left behind.

# **ACCESSIBILITY**

Our brand-new building was built with accessibility at the forefront. As well as lifts and ramps for ease of access, we also have a hearing loop for use in performance spaces and will accommodate our audiences through touch tours to explore performance spaces and BSL interpreted performances. We are proud to have worked with pioneering artists who are striving for greater inclusivity in the Arts including Sandrine Monin and Unbound Dance Theatre.

## INCLUSIVITY

Inclusivity is embedded in the ethos of CAPA College. We have accessible and gender-neutral toilets on all levels, every student is encouraged to choose their own pronouns and adapt their learning accordinaly and, wherever possible, all castina is done blind (without considering race, ethnicity, body shape, sex or gender).

In addition to our Student Support Team, we have an elected team of Student Leaders who advocate for their peers, coordinate student-led "takeovers" and tutorials and ensure the College best represents the needs of its students.



### **Audition**

Applicants will be invited to attend an 'Audition Day' to watch a showcase performance, Q&A with staff and current students, participate in practical workshops and conduct an individual interview.

# STAGE 2

### Outcome

Applicants will receive confirmation of whether or not they have been successful. Some applicants may be invited to the recall stage.

# STAGE 3

### Recall

If you are invited to a recall audition, you will return to CAPA College to present preprepared audition material and participate in a further interview with our team.
